School Fee invoices are distributed to students

September 2024 for Semester 1 and February 2025 for Semester 2

TEXTBOOK DEPOSITS - \$50.00

The textbook deposit is included on each student's fee invoice when they first enrol. For families with two or more students in School District #73, the \$50.00 deposit will be on the oldest 2 students' invoices. Textbook deposits previously paid by students will not be billed again unless they had outstanding textbook charges. **Textbook deposits are refunded once the student leaves the school district (moves or graduates).**

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE - \$10.00

Charged to ALL students for supplies to support general school activities over the school year.

LOCK RENTAL - \$6.00

Charged to ALL students. Students will be assigned a lock by the school at the beginning of the year and will be expected to return the lock at the end of each year until they leave the school. Students are required to use the lock provided by the school.

GRAD FEES - \$85.00

Charged to Grade 12 graduating students includes: Lifetouch grad photo sitting fee, grad gown rental, souvenir hat & tassel, souvenir grad photo composite in folder and other grad incidentals.

YEARBOOK-OPTIONAL FEE - \$40.00

Optional fee to pre-order the school yearbook and keep those GREAT school memories!
